As reviewed by Dane Skelton of Faith Community Church, in his book *The Household and the War for the Cosmos*, "Wiley assumes a basic understanding of

the gospel and spiritual life and moves on to the practical matters of living out the faith in an increasingly unstable world. He unearths the ancient idea of the household, not as a place to eat dinner, watch a sitcom, and go to bed—a place from which we depart every day to work in the "real world"—but as it once was, a spiritual, social, economic, and political shelter that creates a world for generations of those who come under its roof. He uses what I call 'man-speak.' Reading his book is like sitting around the table with Lewis and Clarke, planning their trip or a group of engineers and thinkers, planning to build a city.
